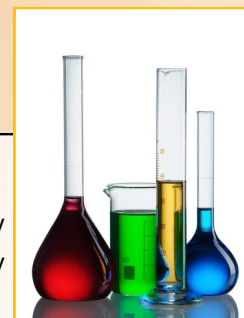




BTEC Level 3 Subsidiary Diploma in Applied Science

Course Structure:

The BTEC Applied Science is a vocational course which involves the study of three mandatory units in Year 12 and three optional units in Year 13. It is most suited for students who enjoy Science but do not want to specialise in totally in one area and it carries 120 UCAS points.

The three mandatory units consist of eleven assignments and the three optional units consist of twelve assignments. These assignments are in form of written essays, practical investigation and presentations. Once submitted the assignment is marked and returned with detailed feedback on how to improve on the grade achieved. The grading criteria are as follows:
